Things to Know

What kind of compensations are possible depends on the individual situation and set of difficulties. Examples are:

- Oral exam instead of a written exam (for example for those with a visual impairment)
- Written exam instead of an oral exam (for example for those with impaired hearing)
 - Extra time during written exams (for example for those with a motor impairment, but also in case of dyslexia, ADHD, diabetes or the need to regularly take sedatives)
- A separate room when taking written exams (for example in the case of disorders leading to significant concentration problems)
 - Writing a research paper instead of giving a presentation
 - Special breaks during exams
 - Extra time when writing a research paper or Bachelor's thesis
 - Permission to use assistive technology or other assistive devices
 - Option to withdraw registration for an exam because of illness
 - Longer intervals between different exams
